

Tracking waste!

"§ 8108. Cannabis Waste Management Plan.

For the purposes of this section, "cannabis waste" is organic waste, as defined in section 42649.8(c) of the Public Resources Code. An applicant's cannabis waste management plan shall identify one or more of the following methods for managing cannabis waste generated on its licensed premises"

- Compost/reintegrate into agricultural use on site
- Local waste authority (pick up or self-haul)



Between harvest and hanging

While harvesting, weight the **WHOLE** plant or **PARTS of EACH PLANT** that is harvested, and record the weight by UID tag number.

All the plants or portion of plants of the same strain, harvested at the same time from the same area and

treated with the same pesticides, are now a **HARVEST BATCH**.

This will typically be given a name such as "Strain Date Farm Initials (optional)"

If you leaf or remove anything prior to hanging, record the weight per **PER STRAIN/HARVEST BATCH**.

Weigh a full tub of leaf, mold and stem when changing strains or Harvest Batches and record **WASTE WEIGHT**.

If sending to another license:

Weigh again to prepare Package Tag UID weights of what will transfer **within two hours** of harvest and freeze or transfer.

If drying for future processing:

Any material that will not be sold/transferred is waste, and needs to be recorded PER HARVEST BATCH.

Retain all inactive UID tags for 6 months past use.
